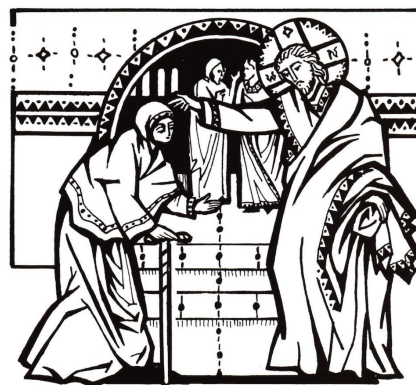

**FUNERALS AT OUR PARISH**

It is essential that you contact Fr Basil as soon as you know your loved one is sick or in the hospital and in need of anointing so that he can perform the sacrament of the sick on the ill person. When your loved one passes from this life, it is important that we honour the deceased with a Christian Funeral. Please contact Fr Basil as soon as you can to let him know that the person has died and then contact a local funeral home for the funeral arrangements. It is important to also meet with Fr Basil before the funeral to discuss the funeral options.

**The Funeral Service**

Typically, a Parastas or Panakhyda (a memorial service also known as Prayers) is held the evening prior to the funeral. On the day of the funeral, in the Ukrainian Catholic Tradition, the Funeral (Burial) Service is held. Consequently, the Divine Liturgy is not typically associated with it. The Roman Catholic church traditionally does a funeral mass, but that is not the tradition in the Ukrainian Catholic church.

Our Church's Funeral Service is truly impressive and deeply meaningful. It is profoundly rooted in the Psalms, Holy Scripture readings, various hymns, and a blessing of the body (that is why the casket should remain open for the entire service).

The service helps as a sincere reflection on life and death, reminding us of the preciousness and brevity of life and the importance of spending it in union with God.

**Cremation**

The Church sincerely recommends preserving the pious custom of burial, but it does not prohibit cremation, unless it is chosen for reasons that are contrary to Christian teachings (Canon 876, §3). If the cremation is preferred due to specific circumstances, please ensure you are well-informed about the current teachings of the Church and the Eparchial policy on this matter. The Eparchial Funeral Directives regarding cremation bear similarities to those of Roman Catholics. However, our Rite has distinct theological and spiritual dimensions that may differ from other religious denominations.

In any case, the decision to cremate should never be made hastily and should always be made in consultation with your parish priest. The Catholic Church strongly recommends that the funeral service be conducted in the presence of the deceased's body prior to cremation. The presence of the body over which the church community offers prayers is an integral and profoundly meaningful aspect of the Church's funeral rites. The majority of parishioners are well-acquainted with our funeral customs. However, if you have any questions, you may always contact Fr Basil, who will be pleased to provide you with any additional information regarding funerals in the Ukrainian Catholic tradition!
