Dear Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

This weekend – *Friday/Saturday* – St. Mary's Church has the privilege of hosting the **35th Eparchial Convention of Saskatchewan** – with some 75 **UCWLC** ladies, an unspecified number of **Brotherhood** and also some **UCY** members participating in the evaluation of the past and the planning for the future. **Bishop Bryan** and **Bishop Peter** of Australia will be two of the many presenters. Everyone leaves late Saturday afternoon to continue their celebrations in their home parishes.... **WELCOME** to all and may the good Lord generously bless all their deliberations...

Please be aware of two other important dates re: our great hero and church leader: **Metropolitan Andrew Sheptytsky** who was born in **1865 (150th Anniversary)** and died on **November 1st, 1944 (70th Anniversary last year)**. Our Ukrainian Episcopal Synod has declared this to be the Year of Metropolitan Andrew – so please become more informed about the saintly man of God. In 1910 and in 1922 this colossal man graced St. Mary's Church and blessed the amazing work of our early Belgian Redemptorist Fathers. Through Metropolitan Andrew's efforts and our **Fr. Achilles Delaere CSsR**, the first Ukrainian Bishop **Mykyta Budka** was appointed to shepherd all the Ukrainians of Canada. He was proclaimed in 2001 by Pope John Paul as **Blessed Nykyta** - our first Ukrainian Canadian Saint. May I encourage you to take the bulletin home and read the two articles about this great man!

Truly I hope that many of you have registered for our **Adult Religious Program** which was initiated last Sunday in the Golden-Agers Centre (*under the church*). It is not too late to join us as we grow more deeply in faith and love. The program will be bi-weekly from **10:00 – 11:00 am** and I cannot recommend it enough. Next Sunday, **November 8th** we will host the second installment. Great DVD presentation and NO homework!!! Do come!

We are most pleased to host some **11** little ones who are being so faithfully prepared by their parents and by our gifted teacher Diane to celebrate their First Solemn Holy Communion. 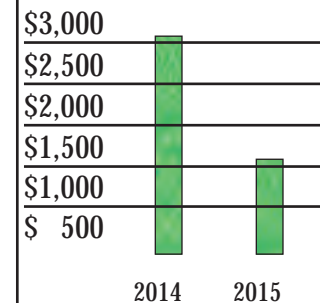
