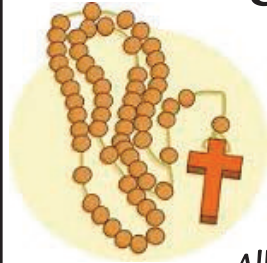

## Христос Воскрес! Christ is Risen!

A man came home from work, tired and irritated to find his 10 year old son waiting for him at the door. "May I ask you a question?" said the son. "Sure, what is it?" said the father. "Daddy, how much do you make an hour?" And the father answered that he makes \$50 an hour. Later the son came to his father and asked if he could borrow \$25. The father was furious. "If the only reason you asked is so that you can buy a silly toy then go straight to your room and leave me alone." The boy quietly went to his room and shut the door. After an hour or so the father started thinking that perhaps the child really needed something and went to the boy's room for a talk.

The father said: "Maybe I spoke too harshly. Here's the \$25 that you asked for". "O thank you" cried the boy, and then reached under his pillow and pulled out some crumbled bills. The man saw that the boy already had money and became angry again. And as the boy slowly counted the money his father asked why he wanted money if he already had some. And the boy answered "Because before I didn't have enough and now I do!" At that moment the son extended the entire sum toward his father and said: "Daddy, I have \$50 now! **Can I buy an hour of your time?**"

What a poignant reminder to each of us. Not everyone has a son... but we all have someone in our lives who sooner or later hungrily awaits our time and maybe would gladly pay \$50 for us to share a kind word with them .

Time has a tendency to fly very quickly. Days blend with weeks and weeks with months. And very often the person that we meant to call waits and waits as we keep telling ourselves that we will get in touch "**tomorrow**".

Let us not wait to give our attention to our child, to our parent or to our dear friend but let us share that \$50 hour TODAY. If we should die tomorrow, the company that we work for could easily replace us with someone else but those who love us will feel the loss for the rest of their lives! Let us be with them while we still can!

Yes, let us give our loved ones the "**gift of our time**"... but let us not stop at time alone. Let us give them our full attention and try to see things from their perspective. Let them feel our love and let us tell them and show them that they make a huge difference in our lives.

Let us remember to give our attention to those whom we love and may I suggest that we not forget the **One who deserves it most!** Let us faithfully turn to our Lord God and tell Him that we are very grateful for His many graces and blessings!

**"I shall pass through this world but once. Therefore, any good that I can do or any kindness that I can show, let me do it NOW before the opportunity escapes, perhaps never to return, causing me regrets..."**

This long weekend in May marks the beginnings of a different life-style - off to the cottage, trips away from the city, planting the garden, enjoying the sun. Let us do all of this with **Jesus** as a "**priority**"! Keep Him with you always!

## Христос Воскрес !

Сьогодні поділюся з вами ще одною історією...

Прийшов змучений і роздратований чоловік з праці і його на порозі зустрів десятилітній син. "Тату, чи можна тебе щось спитати?" "Звичайно," - відповів тато. "А про що йде мова?" "Скільки ти заробляєш на годину" - спитав син? Тато відповів, що заробляє \$50 на годину. Дуже скоро по тій розмові син прийшов до тата і спитав, чи він може від нього позичити \$25. Тато розсердився. "Якщо ти прийшов до мене позичати горші, щоб купити собі непотрібну іграшку, то йди просто до себе в кімнату і залиши мене в спокою." Хлопець спокійно пішов до кімнати і замкнув за собою двері. Годину пізніше чоловік подумав собі, що може син дійсно чогось потребував, і пішов до сина в кімнату на розмову.

І каже тато синові: "Може я не повинен був так гостро тобі відповісти. Маєш. Даю тобі тих \$25, яких ти в мене просив." Син подякував, а тоді сягнув рукою під подушку і витягнув жменю пом'ятих банкнотів. Чоловік побачив, що син вже мав якісь гроші, і знов розсердився. І поки син поволі перераховував все, що мав, тато спитав, чому син потребував гроші, коли він вже гроші мав. "Бо я перед тим не мав відповідної суми, а тепер маю!" Час дуже скоро втікає. Дні зливаються з тижнями, а тижні з місяцями і дуже часто людина, до якої ми мали намір задзвонити, чекає і чекає на нас. А ми собі кажемо, що ми подзвонимо... але «завтра».

Не чекаймо, щоб приділити увагу дитині, батькам або вірному другу і поділімся тою п'ятдесятидолларовою годиною СЬОГОДНІ. Якщо ми мали б завтра померти, нас легко заступлять на місці нашої праці, але той, хто нас любить, відчує великий брак до кінця свого життя! Будьмо з ними поки ще можемо!

Так, даймо тим, кого ми любимо, подарунок свого часу... але не зупиняймося на цьому. Даймо їм також свою увагу і вміймо вислухати їх. Стараймося подивитися на світ з їхньої перспективи і нехай вони відчують нашу любов! Покажимо їм та скажемо їм, що вони відіграють велику роль в нашому житті.

Пам'ятаймо приділити увагу тим, кого ми любимо, але раджу не забувати Того, Хто цього найбільш вартий! Звернімся до Господа Бога... і скажемо Йому, що ми вдячні за Його обильні ласки.

"Я пройдуся цим світом лиш раз. Отож, треба виконати добре діло зараз, поки нагода на це ще не пропала і навіки не залишилася на душі жаль..."
