Beloved Parishioners and Guests,

This is my last bulletin message before I transfer to my new assignment in Winnipeg as Chaplain for Holy Family Seniors' Home and Bethany Home. May I share something I wrote as I left some parishes in the past and please do take this to heart:

A parishioner once wrote: "Something has been bothering me for several years. When our former pastor left, I has asked him if he would return to our parish to celebrate my daughter's wedding. Even though we had a good relationship, he said it wouldn't be proper and said the wedding was the responsibility of the new pastor. Yes, I've been at baptisms and weddings where former priests performed their services. Is there a pastoral policy on this?"

You've asked a good question which often is a source of confusion. The pastor, appointed by the bishop, is assigned to the parish for among other responsibilities the spiritual well-being of the parishioners. He is responsible for the proper administration of the Sacraments. Human nature, being what it is, parishioners sometimes develop close relationships with certain priests. They become family friends. They visit for dinners, golf together, etc. Such relationships are healthy and necessary. However, his prime responsibility for the temporal and spiritual administration in the parish ceases upon his transfer to a new assignment. The sharing of the Sacraments is the privilege of the new priest. Accordingly, the priest who declined your request was only following proper pastoral etiquette so as to not interfere with the ministry of the new pastor.

Many times the transition from one priest to another in a parish could be eased by following several of the following "commandments", which Rev. Eugene Sabin of Tacoma, Washington composed for his parishioners, when he was re-assigned:

Thou shalt not compare the new pastor and the old pastor, for verily, they are two different people.

Thou shalt not say to the new pastor: "But our last pastor did it this way!"

Thou shalt not call back the outgoing pastor for funerals and weddings; yes, these are the responsibilities of ministry for the new pastor.

Thou shalt not send to the former pastor, nor in any way communicate with him, matters of gossip or problems.

Thou shalt not withhold thine exceeding great capacity of love for the new pastor. Thou shalt love, as thou hast loved us – and even more abundantly!

Thou shalt not prejudge persons and things for the new pastor. He will have the ability to judge for himself in wisdom and in truth.

Thou shalt not speak too often of thy former pastor, and when thou dost, may it be kindly.

Thou shalt not forget to pray for the new pastor regularly; to enthusiastically await his coming; to warmly welcome his arrival; to follow his leadership, not expecting too much from him, and **love him** with all your heart!

I warmly cherish and appreciate the privilege of serving and loving you over the past four years and sincerely ask you to **love the new priests** as much as you have cared for us! I heart-fully and lovingly ask you to continue praying for us!

**SASKATCHEWAN KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS
CHARITABLE FOUNDATION
SASK K OF C VOCATION ENDOWMENT UPDATE**



The Sask K of C Vocation Endowment initiative has proven to be a rewarding and satisfying experience. In our initial year, we exceeded our target by raising in excess of \$300,000.00 in donations. Coupled with the commitment made by the Sask K of C Charitable Foundation to match the first \$250,000.00, we now have approximately \$550,000.00 in the Sask K of C Vocations Endowment Fund. We are extremely grateful for the leadership, support, and encouragement offered by all clergy, councils & parishioners throughout the province in making this success a reality.

The Sask K of C Vocation Endowment was introduced as a three year initiative and we are now in preparation for the second year of fundraising. We have established a target of \$250,000.00 for the year and will once again ask for your assistance as we further crystalize the partnership between our stakeholders throughout the province.

The Sask K of C Vocation Endowment strategy was designed to pay an equal amount to each Seminarian based on the earnings generated from the Fund each year. This year we paid out \$1,000.00 to each of the 14 Seminarians associated with the Dioceses & Eparchy in Saskatchewan. It is important to note that the \$14,000.00 paid out to the Seminarians was from the earnings of the Vocation Endowment fund. We will not pay out any of the principal. Every dollar donated to the Sask K of C Vocations Endowment will continue to earn revenue in perpetuity for the training and development of priests.

The Knights of Columbus Supreme Office offers an RSVP program to encourage Knights of Columbus Councils & members to support the training and development of our clergy. This RSVP program will provide us with a rebate of 20% for each dollar paid out to the Seminarians. When received, these RSVP rebate dollars will be deposited directly into the Vocation Endowment fund to further assist in future earnings.

On behalf of the 10,000 Knights of Columbus members and 138 Knight of Columbus Councils within the province, we sincerely thank you for your ongoing generosity and support. We are optimistic and confident that together we can achieve our three-year target of \$1,000,000.00 as we build a sustainable fund for the training and development of the future leaders of our Church.

WELCOME TO ST. MARY'S PARISH....

Father Leonid Malkov, CSsR

He was born on March 6, 1960 in Vorkuta, Siberia where almost all our Ukrainian Bishops served prison sentences. His father, Volodimir, came from Russia, Yaroslavl' district. His mother, Anna Honchar came from Boykyvschyny, from village Tysiv, Bolekhiv County. All his mother's family were taken to Siberia. In 1967, the year Leonid went to primary school in Siberia. In 1970 the whole family moved to the Dolyna, Ivano-Frankivsk. In 1973, the year the whole family moved to Chervonohrad, Lviv region. After successfully completing ten years school and music school in 1977, he was called to military service in the Soviet army in 1979, like all young boys over 18 years. In 1984 he entered the novitiate Redemptorist Fathers in Lviv and started theological studies in the Redemptorist Fathers underground seminary. After passing the exams successfully been ordained a deacon by Bishop Philemon Kurchaba on June 16, 1990. The next day, June 17, he was ordained a priest by Bishop Philemon. He simultaneously participated in studies of theology of the Fathers from abroad who often visited Ukraine while being acting pastor in villages and Bruhovychi tags. In 1993 he was appointed steward of the Redemptorist Fathers Monastery in Ternopil, where he was building the monastery and the Church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. In May of 1994 by order of the Provincial Father Igor Wozniak he left for America, for spiritual work among Ukrainian neighborhood in Newark, NJ working eight years as assistant pastor of the church of St. John the Baptist. In 2002, by order of the Provincial Fr. Michael Woloshyn he moved to Saskatchewan to serve eight parishes in Wynyard and district area. In 2004, by order of the Provincial and at the request of Metropolitan Stefan Soroka he returned back to America, where he held the post of pastor of the Church of St. John the Baptist in Newark and abbot of the monastery. From 2015, he served as assistant pastor in the Church of Saints Peter and Paul in Saskatoon.



Father Yevhen Zadorozhnyi, CSsR

- I was born on April 26, 1972, in a village called Spas near Lviv, in Ukraine.
- I attended school from 1978 to 1989.
- From 1989 to 1991 I studied at Uzhgorod University in the College of Mathematics.
- In 1990 I joined the Redemptorist Fathers.
- In 1996 I was ordained a priest.
- I served in Kamianec-Podilsky, Ternopil, Vinnytsia, Ocheretnia, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kuznetsovsk, and in Kovel from 2002 to 2013
