Welcome Вітаємо

Слава Ісусу Христу !

Glory be to Jesus Christ !

Thank you for praying and visiting with us at St. Mary's. Before you leave please take some time to admire some of our treasures.

Our Dome depicts a beautiful original artwork of the Coronation of Mary, the Mother of God, in heaven. It is the work of the late Stephen Meush, who undertook this work at the age of 36. It took years to complete (1939-1941).

The Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help behind the altar was written by Igor Sulhacev of Toronto and was installed in 1964. It is a representation of the original Miraculous Icon which is venerated today in the church of St. Alphonsus in Rome. Pope Pius X entrusted this Miraculous Icon to the Redemptorists with the instruction: "See to it that Our Mother of Perpetual Help is made known throughout the world." It is most fitting that the Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help holds the place of honour in our church, the Motherhouse of the Ukrainian Catholic Redemptorists.

The Bust of Fr. Achilles Delaere, CSsR, located in the south entrance of the church, is a creation of the famous Ukrainian Canadian artist Leo Mol of Winnipeg. Fr. Delaere, a Belgian Roman Catholic priest of the Redemptorist Congregation, saw the great spiritual needs of the early Ukrainian immigrants. Knowing that these people did not have their own priest, Fr. Delaere, along with other Redemptorists "became" Ukrainian Catholic in order to serve the early immigrants.

The Altar was installed in 1965. It is also the creation of Igor Sulhacev. At the base of the altar are 28 figurines, representing saints of the Eastern Church.

The Icon of the First Ukrainian Catholic Redemptorist Martyrs. On June 27, 2001, Pope John Paul II beatified 27 martyrs for the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Among these heroes of faith are four Redemptorists:

Bishop Nicholas Charnetsky, CSsR, Bishop Vasyl Velychkovsky, CSsR,
Fr. Zenon Kovalyk, CSsR & Fr. Ivan Ziatyk, CSsR

This icon depicting these holy ones was written by Fr. Thomas Loya of Chicago. It was installed and blessed during St. Mary's Annual "Vidpust" Pilgrimage in June 2002.

HOLINESS: “Holy this moment, joyous voices ringing...” is a traditional Ukrainian hymn which is very familiar to most of us. Holiness is however, something many of us think about only in the context of church and not as personally applicable to our daily lives. Nothing could be further from the truth. Pope Francis, in his exhortation *Gaudete et exsultate* reminds us that God calls all to holiness. Matthew Kelly, in his recent book, *The Biggest Lie in the History of Christianity*, (p. 50-52) suggests that a denial of our capacity for achieving holiness robs us of our ability to access the transforming power of God to be the best version of ourselves that we can be. He says if we want to be truly happy we MUST seek holiness. One way we can begin to do that, Kelly teaches, is by integrating **holy moments** into our everyday lives...here are some suggestions on where to start:

1. Begin each day with a short prayer of gratitude for another day. Remember all LIFE is a gift from God even when we face challenges and difficulties.
2. Go out of your way to do something for your spouse that you would rather not do as an intentional act of love.
3. Offer the least enjoyable task of your day as a prayer for someone who is suffering.
4. Control your temper, even if you are justified in losing it. Stay calm in the midst of crisis.
5. Before making any decision ask yourself if it will make you a better version of yourself. Choose the best version of yourself even if you don't feel like it.
6. Encourage, coach, praise or affirm someone. We all need more of those positives.
7. Be patient with someone who drives you crazy.
8. Do someone else's chores.
9. Offer to pray with someone, rather than just for them. In that you help them learn how to pray, and give your active support in taking the first step.
10. Make a healthy food/drink choice.
11. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle—they are Ukrainian traditions that will make your Baba proud and show that you care for God's creation.
12. Get honest with yourself about your self-destructive habits. (Monthly sacramental confession is great place to start to work on these issues—we all have them.)
13. Tell God you trust he has a great plan for you and your life. (Jer. 29:11)
14. Give whoever is in front of you, your full attention.
15. Tell someone your faith story, share a life changing book or your experience of the blessings of wholeheartedly following Christ.
